The Chairman, of the committee, Dr Navdeep Singh Lamba welcomed all members. The minutes of the previous meeting held on 6th March, 2026 were approved by the members. The following was discussed and decisions were taken:

1. **Successful conduct of CISP in April, 2026:**

It was informed that CISP was organized on 9th and 10th April, 2026. The sessions were allotted as per NMC guidelines. A total of 30 participants attended the workshop. The feedback given by the participants was shared with the members.

2. **Planning of BCME in August, 2026**

It was planned that keeping in view of faculty vacations, BCME would be planned in August, 2026. The members of medical Education Unit would be the resource faculty and only 3 sessions maximum will be taken by members of curriculum committee.

3. **Discussion of Curriculum Innovation project of ACME applicants**

The projects of Dr Beena and Dr Priyanka Kadian was put up in the meeting and discussed with all members present. After few amendments, the project was finalized and approved by all members.

4. **Remedial classes Attendance of AETCOM and Pandemic module**

It was informed by Dr Swati Mittal, AETCOM Co-ordinator that Remedial classes on AETCOM in MBBS Phase 1 were held for students, who were short of attendance, in March-April, 2026. All Phase 1 students have completed their eligibility, based on AETCOM attendance.

5. **Planning to conduct Electives for MBBS Batch 2023**

As per the directions from the PGIMS, Rohtak, the Electives for MBBS Batch 2023 are due from 1st September, 2026. For this, it was decided that development of new and innovative modules for Electives, as suggested by the NMC in CBME 2024 guidelines, would be encouraged. The proposed modules of electives shall be put up in the subsequent meeting of Curriculum committee, before implementation.

6. **Implementation of blueprints of MBBS Phase 2 subjects**

It was informed to all that an academic meeting of all heads of departments of MBBS Phase 2 subjects of all colleges under PGIMS, Rohtak was held on 13th May, 2026. The blueprints of MBBS Phase 2 subjects were prepared and finalized by the faculty members. These could be implemented in Phase 2 curriculum before Batch 2024 goes for final University examination in August, 2026.


7. **Filling of Feedback form for curriculum committee meeting:**
