



This lab with its attached aseptic room is suitable for staining and identification of microorganism like bacteria and fungi.




Human Anatomy & Physiology & Pharmacology lab:


Hospital & Clinical Pharmacy Lab

The lab is equipped with clinical instruments such as Blood pressure monitor, variety of syringes, Catheters, Oxygen mask etc.




Model Pharmacy Lab

Library



Room Charges

Mess Charges

EXAMINATION- REGULATION

1. A student may be allowed to appear in the examination of each semester if he/she has attended a minimum of 80% in theory and practical in each subject (for B Pharm. Program) and 75% in theory and practical in each subject (for D. Pharm. Program).
2. For Diploma in Pharmacy: A student shall be declared PASS and eligible for getting grade in a course of D. Pharm. program if he/she secures at least 40% marks in that particular subject including internal assessment.
3. For B. Pharm.: A student shall be declared PASS and eligible for getting grade in a course of B. Pharm. program if he/she secures at least 50% marks in that particular subject including internal assessment.
4. A student has to pass in theory and practical exam separately in each of the papers.

ANTI RAGGING

Definition of Ragging Ragging shall mean any disorderly conduct, whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

What constitutes Ragging Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts

- ✓ any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student
- ✓ asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student,
- ✓ any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher,
- ✓ exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of student,
- ✓ any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students;
- ✓ any act of physical abuse including all variants of it sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person
- ✓ indulging in rowdy or indiscipline activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof any fresher or any other student.
- ✓ any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student;
- ✓ any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of color, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background.
- ✓ any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.

✓any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

Action to be taken by the Head of the institution -

On receipt of the recommendation of the Anti-Ragging Squad or on receipt of any information concerning any reported incident of ragging, the Head of institution shall immediately determine if a case under the penal laws is made out and if so, either on his own or through a member of the Anti-Ragging Committee authorized by him in this behalf, proceed to file a First Information Report (FIR), within twenty four hours of receipt of such information or recommendation, with the police and local authorities, under the appropriate penal provisions relating to one or more of the following, namely,

- i. Abetment to ragging;**
- ii. Criminal conspiracy to rag.**
- iii. Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging,**
- iv. Public nuisance created during ragging;**
- v. Violation of decency and morals through ragging,**
- vi. Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt;**
- vii. Wrongful restraint,**
- viii. Wrongful confinement;**
- ix. Use of criminal force,**
- x. Assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences;**
- xi. Extortion,**
- xii. Criminal trespass,**
- xiii. Offences against property;**
- xiv. Criminal intimidation,**
- xv. Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim(s);**
- xvi. Threat to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim(s);**
- xvii. Physical or psychological humiliation,**
- xviii. All other offences following from the definition of "Ragging"**

Administrative action in the event of ragging:-

The institution shall punish a student found guilty of ragging after following procedure and in the manner prescribed herein under

The Anti-Ragging, Committee of the institution shall take an appropriate decision, in regard to punishment or otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging established in the recommendations of the Anti-Ragging Squad. The Anti-Ragging Committee may, depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the Anti-Ragging Squad, award, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments, namely;

- i. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- ii. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
- iii. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process withholding results
- iv. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- v. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
- vi. Cancellation of admission.
- vii. Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.
- viii. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF COLLEGE

General rules and regulations:

Every student admitted to B.pharmacy and D.pharmacy courses shall have to follow rules and regulations of the institute.

1. All decisions taken by the management are final.
2. Students must assemble in the college campus for the prayer sharp at 8.45 am every day. Students are required to be regular and punctual for the class.
3. Students are expected to be in the class at least 5 minutes before the commencement of the period.
4. Students should maintain perfect order and strict silence inside the lecture hall.
5. Movement outside the class room in between lectures should be minimum and for valid reasons only.
6. Loitering around the corridors during classes and attending other classes are not allowed.
7. Students should maintain silence in the class, library, reading room and in the corridors.
8. Students should make every effort to take care of the college and hospital property and help in maintaining the same. They should not write on the black board, scribble on tables, chairs, walls etc.
9. Students are not allowed to come directly to the Principal office without permission of the class coordinator, until there is any emergency.
10. If the students have any problem, they should inform the class representative and the class representative will intimate it to the class coordinators. If the problem is not solved at the class coordinator's level, then the class students should by-pass the above mentioned channels. Exceptions are allowed only if the problem is utmost urgent/serious.
11. Students are required to maintain ethical and professional standards in behavior both inside and outside the college, hospital, hostel and community premises.
12. Each student is responsible for the proper handling and safe custody of any apparatus or equipment that she may be using in different pharmacy labs. Misuse or negligence will result in replacement of the particular item by the candidate. Any willful damage done to the property of the college or hospital will be treated as breach of discipline.
13. Students are not allowed to paste notices within the institutions without prior written permission from the Office of the Principal.
14. Students are forbidden to communicate with any person outside the authority without permission from the Office of the Principal.
15. Any student who damages the reputation of the institute in any way is liable to be expelled. If any student discontinues the course, she shall clear all dues before leaving the college. If she fails to pay her original certificates will be retained and will be returned once the dues are cleared by the student.
16. Violating the rules of institute / hostel will be dealt with seriously by the college authorities and if necessary dismissal from the college may be considered depending upon the seriousness of the violation.
17. Rules are subject to change from time to time

UNIFORM

Wearing of uniform is compulsory in the institute.

Working hours:

- During summer: 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- During winter: 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Vacations: As per PT. B.D. Sharma University norms.

Holidays: As per decisions of the management.

Leave:

1. The period of ANY TYPE of leave (including sick leave) will be considered as ABSENCE for purpose of determination of candidate's eligibility to appear in the university examination and also for computation of internal assessment.
2. In all cases leave taken will be at student's own risk so far as the percentage of attendance is considered and even medical certificate will not make up for deficiency in attendance.
3. Sick leave will only be granted on the production of valid medical certificate from an authorized medical officer. The student will submit a fitness certificate from same doctor before rejoining.
4. A medical certificate must specify the nature of illness and the period with dates of leave recommended on account of that illness.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF LIBRARY

1. The library will be open on all working days from 9.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m.
2. Silence and order must be maintained in the library at all times. All kinds of eatables/drinks are prohibited in the library. Any violation of the rules will result in serious disciplinary action.
3. Any person who loses/defaces or otherwise seriously damages books etc. shall be liable to pay the cost of the replacement and in the event of the book being one of the set or series, the cost of the replacement shall be paid by the person, if the single copy lost/damaged is not available.
4. The following shall be entitled to the use the library:
 - a. The Faculty of the Pharmacy College.
 - b. Students of the Pharmacy College.
5. Only two books will be issued for taking out from the library at a time by the candidate.
6. No book shall be kept by any student for more than 07 days. This privilege does not include the vacations. For each extra succeeding day that a book be kept there shall be a fine of Rs. 5/- per book per day. Further issue of books shall be stopped till the fine is paid and the book returned to the library.
7. Reference books, rare books and current Periodicals will not be issued.
8. The Librarian may recall any book at any time, if necessary, even before the expiry date.
9. If the reason of non-return of book in time is beyond the control of the student, amount of fine may be reduced at the discretion of the Principal.
10. Every student will be issued one library membership cards. If a card is lost, a new card is to be purchased from the librarian at prescribed cost. The library membership card is not transferable.
11. The book card placed in the pocket at the end of the book must be delivered to the librarian before the book is taken away and the borrower must have it stamped.
12. During stock checking, which will be notified in advance, all books issued must be returned.
13. Periodicals and newspapers should not be taken away under any circumstances from the Library.

NOTE: Any term/condition/situation not covered by above mentioned rules and instructions shall be decided by the Principal of Adesh College of Pharmacy.

RULES AND REGULATION OF HOSTEL

All hostellers / residents, guests and visitors to the hostels should conduct themselves in a manner that is in keeping with the prestige, honour, and dignity of **ADESH COLLEGE OF PHARMACY**.

1. Hostellers / residents are expected to maintain discipline and decorum not only in the hostel but also in the institutional campus. They must respect privacy, dignity and belongings of fellows/ residents, visitors and guests irrespective of age, gender, social standing, seniority, discipline of study, position etc.
2. Hostellers / residents should not behave in manner that disturbs the learning of fellow-hostellers / residents. Maintaining the best possible conditions for studying and rest is the responsibility of every hosteller/ resident.
3. Hostellers should refrain from making noise, shouting or create disturbance in any form.
4. Radios, music systems and other such appliances must be played at an appropriate volume or earphones may be used so as not to cause any disturbance to others.
5. Party/celebrations of any form are not permitted in the hostels without prior permission of the Chief Warden who may earmark specific areas for this purpose.
6. Hostellers must take care of hostel and institutional property.
7. Hostellers should not deface, alter, or destroy any hostel or institutional property. Vandalism is a serious offence.
8. Ragging in any form within and outside the hostels is banned in the country as directed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
9. At no time shall hostellers / residents argue unnecessarily, abuse, threaten or misbehave with any institute employee (Including security staff who may interact with them during their duty).
10. **ADESH COLLEGE OF PHARMACY** is declared a "No Smoking zone". Hence smoking in premises is completely banned.
11. Use of tobacco and its products are not permitted in the hostels.
12. In view of the known health hazards hostellers / residents are advised to refrain themselves from smoking and use of tobacco.
13. Consumption of alcohol, intoxicating substance and illicit drugs is banned in the hostel.
14. Alcohol should not be served in parties / celebrations within the hostel campus even when permission for such parties/ celebrations has been obtained from the Chief Warden.

15. It is illegal to possess recreational or prohibited drugs.
16. Possession, use, peddling etc of any recreational or prohibited drugs is a criminal offence.
17. Hostellers must not indulge in violence or in actions leading to physical or mental harm to anyone.
18. Hostellers / residents should not possess any weapons or replicas of weapons or any other article that may cause physical harm.
19. Hostellers / residents should not at any time bring in unauthorized or unknown individuals into the hostel premises.

Emergency reporting

The hostellers must report immediately to the Hostel Section/ Security in following circumstances:

1. Issues related to security or threat in the hostel premises and act of vandalism.
2. Act of misconduct including ragging and illness of self or any hosteller / resident.
3. Unusual behaviour of any hosteller/ resident including behaviour that may in his / her opinion amount to depression, detachment, no response from a room locked from inside, missing neighbour etc.
4. Mishaps including fires, accidents to self or fellow-hostellers / residents within and outside the hostels.
5. Criminal or anti-national activity in the hostel premises.

Religious activities:

The institution practices secularism and respects all religious faiths and beliefs. However, the hostel premises should not be used for any religious activities and congregations.

Parents and guardians:

1. All hostellers/ residents and their parents and guardians have right to report and seek redressal of grievances within the institution.
2. Hostellers / residents and their parents and guardians are requested not to influence the working of the hostel or its committees in any manner so as not to bias or prejudice decisions.
3. Hostellers/ residents and their parents and guardians are encouraged to suggest improvements in the functioning of the hostels.
4. Constructive criticisms / suggestions may be written to the Warden/ Director. Suggestions that are likely to influence policy decisions on a long term are usually discussed in the meetings of the Hostel Management.

Maintenance:

- 1.All hostellers/ residents / guests/ visitors shall take utmost care of hostel premises, hostel, and institutional property.
- 2.All hostellers /residents, guests and visitors shall ensure all furniture, fixtures, furnishings are handled with care and maintained properly.
- 3.Vandalism and graffiti is a serious offence.
- 4.No furniture, fixture or furnishing shall be moved from one room to another.
- 5.In the event of wear and tear or damage or defect of any of the furniture, fixtures, or furnishings either in the room or in the common areas, the Hostel Section / Maintenance/ Enquiry should be informed for necessary action.
- 6.The institution may decide on the use of electrical appliances from time to time.
- 7.Room heaters, heat convectors, and all power appliances are not permitted in any of the hostels.
- 8.All hostellers / residents shall switch-off all lights, fans and plug points before leaving the room or when not in use and ensure their maintenance.
- 9.Drawing of electricity by making additional conduits or opening of existing fixtures for such purpose is prohibited.
- 10.Electrical appliances in the washroom such as water heaters/ solar heated geysers etc must be handled with care.
- 11.No hosteller / resident / guest/ visitor shall touch or attempt to repair electrical fixture/ connection/ circuit breaker / junction box etc.
- 12.All damaged or non-functional electric points should be immediately reported to the Hostel Section / Maintenance/ Enquiry.
- 13.Water is a scarce commodity and wastage is discouraged and should be always avoided. All water leakages should be reported immediately to the Hostel Section/ Maintenance/Enquiry.
- 14.All hostellers / residents/ guests /visitors shall keep the hostel accommodation and the hostel premises as well as surroundings, neat and clean.
- 15.All garbage, rubbish and refuse including disposable wares should be disposed of in the garbage bins provided or in the designated areas.
- 16.All hostellers/ residents shall inform the Hostel Section if at any time they find lack of cleanliness and hygiene in any of the eateries/ mess/ drinking water dispensers etc in the hostel premises.
- 17.Should no action be taken within a reasonable period [even immediate if so warranted], the Hostel Committee should be intimated.
- 18.Any collection of water in the hostel premises including water coolers, unused containers, disposable glasses, flowerpots etc. especially during the rainy season should be viewed as a serious lapse of cleanliness and sanitation and reported immediately to the Hostel Section/ Sanitation Department / cleaners posted there.

Safety & Security

1. All hostellers / residents / guests / visitors shall take all precautions and cooperate with the authorities to maintain safety and security of the hostel premises.
2. While reporting matters related to safety and security, if the situation so warrants, the name of the hosteller/ resident shall be kept in confidence.
3. All hostellers / residents shall report immediately to the security staff if they are witness to or are aware of:
 - a. Any suspicious individual / individuals in the hostel premises.
 - b. Any vehicle or suspicious articles lying unattended in the hostels.
 - c. Any unauthorized or illegal activity within the hostel premises.
 - d. An act of ragging.
 - e. An act of abuse in any form.
4. All accommodation is provided with facilities for locking and it is expected that doors should be always locked for reasons of security. Hostellers/ residents who are likely to remain outside the hostels [e.g., while going home on a vacation] are required to inform the Hostel Section with contact details and inform their neighbours.
5. All valuables should be placed in secure place. Keeping of large amount of cash in hostel rooms is discouraged. Laptops and other valuables should be insured against theft and pilferage.
6. No unauthorized person is permitted in the hostels.
7. It is mandatory for all hostellers/ residents to always carry their institutional Identity Card. They should produce them whenever requested by appropriate authorities and appreciate that entry to hostels may be barred without proper identification.
8. All guests / visitors should be able to prove their identity or should be accompanied by a bonafide hosteller/ resident with an identity card.
9. Any un-authorized person in the hostel premises should be reported to the Security immediately.
10. All delivery personnel should be contacted and met at the hostel entrance and should not be allowed to enter hostel premises in the interest of security of self and others.
11. Courier and posts can be received in the Hostels at the entrance from the Security Guards.
12. All visitors including parents and guardians should be met at the gate or visitors' room.
13. No guests including Parents & Relatives are allowed to go into the rooms of the hostellers without prior permission of the Chief Warden of the Hostels.
14. The female visitors are not allowed to go into the rooms of Gents' Hostel.
15. The male visitors are not allowed to go into the rooms of the ladies Hostels/ Students Nurses Hostel.

16. Hostellers/ residents are not permitted to employ maids / servants.
17. Hazardous material of any kind is restricted / banned in hostel premises
18. Any material that is a fire-risk should be avoided or used cautiously in the hostels. This includes, candles, incense sticks, [use with caution and put off before leaving the room] firecrackers, gas cylinders, petroleum products etc. [not permitted].
19. Insecticides, toxins, poisons of any kind are not to be kept in rooms. Mosquito repellents should be used provided there is no known allergy to these substances.
20. Weapons of any kind are forbidden to be brought or kept in the hostel premises.
21. All hostellers/ residents are to report to the Hostel Section and Security the presence of any hazardous material including weapons of any kind in the hostel premises.
22. Cooking, boiling, microwaving, baking etc are not permitted in the hostels.

Health

1. All hostellers / residents should take adequate care to remain healthy and fit.
2. All hostellers / residents are required to take care of their health with the facilities available.
3. All hostellers / residents shall inform the Hostel Section of any form of illness of self or their fellow-hostellers so that appropriate assistance could be rendered.
4. All hostellers/ residents on regular medication are advised to intimate the Hostel Section, in confidence regarding their medication.
5. The Hostel Section shall maintain absolute confidentiality of the illness. The Hostel Section shall provide all necessary assistance.
6. The treating physician shall be informed of any adverse situations.
7. The parents / guardians shall be informed of any adverse situations.
8. Hostellers / residents must intimate the Hostel Section regarding any injury or bodily harm to self or fellow hostellers/ residents even if sustained outside the hostel premises.
9. All hostellers / residents **MUST** inform the warden if suffering from any communicable disease

Students Out Pass

1. All students should take prior permission from Principal/hostel warden/hostel authority on weekdays if they want to go out for night stay from hostel.
2. Leave for more than three days will only be granted under special circumstances.
3. Leave will be denied to students who are not meeting the mandatory attendance.
4. Weekend passes can be availed by students whose home address as per college record is within 20Km of the college campus
5. Students leaving the campus before 4PM need to take a gate out pass from the warden.
6. Students not reporting back from leave on time and not notifying the college about the delay will be black listed and will be denied leave for a period of three months.


