

Sir/Madam,

In continuation of this Ministry's letter of even number dated 12.05.2017 and the Principal, Adesh Medical College & Hospital, Shahbad letter's No. AMCH/Estt./05/2k17/939 dated 26.05.2017 furnishing required undertaking & Bank Guarantee, I am directed to convey the formal permission of the Central Government for establishment of new Medical College at Shahbad, Haryana in the name & Style of **ADESH MEDICAL COLLEGE & HOSPITAL** by Adesh Welfare Society, Punjab with an annual intake of 150 MBBS students for the academic year 2017-18 under Section 10 A of the IMC Act, 1956.

2. This permission of the Central Government is accorded initially for a period of one year and will be renewed on yearly basis subject to verification of achievement of annual targets as indicated in your scheme. This process of renewal of permission will continue till such time the infrastructure and expansion of hospital facilities are completed as per norms of Medical Council of India. The next batch of students shall be admitted only after obtaining permission of the Central Government.
3. The Government Medical Colleges (except those located in J&K, Andhra Pradesh & Telangana States) shall contribute 15% of MBBS seats for which the LoP is granted for all India quota.
4. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as irregular and action under IMC Act, 1956 & Regulations made thereunder will be initiated.
5. Discrepancies, if any, may be brought to the notice of MCI and Central/State Government.
6. Kindly acknowledge receipt of this letter.
